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The Audit of the Given

Every system begins by deciding what may be treated as evidence.

The ordinary mind receives a condition, names it, locates it in matter or circumstance, and then submits to the name as though the description were the cause. A forensic mind does something different. It asks what claim has been admitted as governing, how that claim reproduces itself, and whether it possesses any legitimate authority at all.

Forensic Reality Engineering begins at that threshold. It is not the management of an accepted sentence. It is the audit of the court that presumed the right to issue the sentence.

The architect does not begin by decorating the prison. The architect examines the blueprint.

A condition can appear intimate, historical, embodied, or inevitable and still be operating as a repeated premise. The first discipline is therefore neither optimism nor denial. It is exact inspection: What is the asserted law? What is the source assigned to it? What keeps it phase-locked to perception? What would remain if its claim to authorship were withdrawn?

This is the difference between reaction and audit. Reaction accepts the object and struggles with it. Audit suspends the object's presumed authority long enough to investigate the mechanism by which it is being experienced as real.

THE CANONICAL DEFINITION

Forensic Reality Engineering is the application of destructive interference, phase-lock analysis, and sovereign decree to the human bio-field. It treats disease, scarcity, and trauma not as fixed conditions but as corrupted frequencies — and provides a repeatable protocol (The First Note, The Quad-Command) to nullify and replace them. It is the convergence of Christian Science metaphysics, dielectric field theory, and forensic systems analysis.

Three movements organize the work:

AUDIT. Identify the governing claim, inherited premise, or repeating pattern being treated as reality.

VOID. Challenge the claim at its asserted source rather than negotiating with its surface effects.

REWRITE. Establish the chosen governing premise through a disciplined, repeatable protocol.

These movements are not offered here as slogans. They are the beginning of an evidentiary method. Each must become precise enough to be repeated, tested within the framework, documented, and distinguished from wishful thinking.
